Historical Path of the Clinic

- ➤ Continues the tradition of Surgical Department then operating within the framework of Tuberculosis Military Institute, established in 1959
- Colonel Prof. Dr. Ervin Ginzberg was the Head of the Surgical Department between 1959 and 1981
- ➤ Having moved into the MMA new building in 1981, the Clinic for Cardiac and Thoracic Surgery was formed
- ➤ Colonel Dr. Dragomir Cvetanovic headed the Department of Chest Surgery between 1981 and 1994
- ➤ Major General Prof. Dr. Vladislav Stepic headed the Department of Chest Surgery between 1994 and 2002





Historical Path of the Clinic

- ➤ Lt. Col. Assist. Prof. Dr. Vlado Cvijanovic was the head of the Department of Chest Surgery from 2002 to 2005
- ➤ In 2005, Clinic for Chest Surgery was formed
- ➤ Colonel Prof. Dr. Vojkan Stanic headed the Clinic between 2005 and 2012

> Blunt injury 186 16%

> Gunshot wound 45,5%

> Blast lung injury 0,5%

> Comparing to all injuries 12%
